

# **2011-12 CLOQUET POOL LEAGUE PRE-SEASON MEETING MINUTES**

**The following items were discussed and voted on at the pre-season meeting on 09/01/11.**

## **No Sanction Fees & No State Tournament**

The Cloquet Pool League will be an independent pool league, which means the players do not have to pay any Sanction Fees. However, this also means the teams will not be able to compete in any State Tournaments.

## **Substitute Players**

Because there are only so many pool players, sometimes it's difficult to find a substitute player. In order to make things a little easier, the league will allow a player to play for two different teams a maximum of twice per team. However, once a player plays for a team three times, they become a permanent member of that team, and can no longer play for the other team.

## **Turn In League Envelopes at River Inn**

Teams must turn in the league match envelopes to Randy Stolan at the River Inn. Randy will handle all the league money, so if you write a check for league dues make it payable to "River Inn". Randy will give the score sheets to Jeff Schelin to compile the weekly statistics.

## **Weekly Stats Online**

## **Starting Handicaps & New Player Handicaps**

For the first three weeks of leagues, players are to use their handicap from the end of last year as shown on the handicap list in the team packet (Handicaps were taken off the Midwest Coin website.). If a player did not play last year, they are to use the New Player Handicap of 7.5 for men and 6.5 for women.

### **League Income**

The sponsoring bar of each team will pay a \$50 Sponsor Fee. Each team will pay \$25 Weekly Dues (\$5 per player) each night of leagues.

### **League Expenses**

The only expenses the league will incur for the year are: 1) the initial cost to start the league such as photocopies and folders for the team packets, and 2) Jeff Schelin will compile the league stats each week for a one-time charge of \$300.00.

### **Pay-Outs**

At the end of the season, 100% of the money (less league expenses) will be paid back to the teams as follows: 1) the 1<sup>st</sup> place team will receive a \$100.00 bonus and the 2<sup>nd</sup> place team will receive a \$50.00 bonus, and 2) the rest of the money will be paid back to the teams based 1/3<sup>rd</sup> on Rounds Won and 2/3<sup>rd</sup> on Points Scored.
